Project I Am: Next Up aims to assist hundreds of youths nationwide with becoming changemakers, starting with volunteerism. The goal is to help youth see their potential, expose them to new opportunities and ultimately

help shape productive society members as they enter adulthood.

This project is designed as an expansion initiative for Project I Am to become a national organization, implementing Afterschool Community Service Clubs. Thanks to the support of Riley's Way Foundation and DTLR, three schools in Atlanta, GA, Baltimore, MD and Normal, IL, had launched Project I Am: Next Up by the end of 2023.

7-YEAR ANNIVERSARY

Project I Am celebrates 100,000 people being impacted for the 7 year anniversary blessing bag stuffing event. Project I Am partnered with the Chicago White Sox Ace program.







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DON'T WAIT TO BE GREAT 2.0

Project I Am was a grantee of the Obama Foundation's Freedom Summer initiative. Led by Jahkil Jackson and subject experts, the safe summer program took a holistic approach to exposing 20 youth of color on the South and West sides of Chicago to leadership through social entrepreneurship and sports.

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HOLIDAY GIVE BACK

Project I Am partners with True Star Media to distribute coats, toys, socks, and lunch to families at the Primo Center for Women & Children.



GIWINGTUESDAY

Giving Tuesday is known as a global generosity movement unleashing the power of people and organizations to transform their communities and the world. Project I Am introduced Virtual Packing Parties in 2020 when the world was in COVID quarantine with 50 volunteers creating 500 blessing bags simultaneously via Zoom.

2023 saw the largest growth and engagement so far, with over 1,150 volunteers from nearly 50 cities creating 15,000 blessing bags for Giving Tuesday. To date, Project I Am's Giving Tuesday initiative has worked with over 2,250 youth volunteers from over 75 cities, creating a total of 37,500 blessing bags for the unhoused in their cities..




